- This position provides technical support and assistance in the area of range conservation, range management, and range improvement including: conducting range monitoring such as condition and trend, utilization, and other pertinent studies for the purpose of allotment evaluation. If selected, you will prepare reports, maps, etc... for the rangeland management program. With the dispersed land ownership pattern of the Buffalo Field Office and the extensive energy development of the area, the workload is complex and challenging. GIS and GPS knowledge would be very helpful.
- The Buffalo Field Office of the BLM is located in Buffalo Wyoming, in north central Wyoming on the east side of the Big Horn Mountains. Buffalo has a population of around 4500 people. Buffalo is a small town with 3 stop lights, but does provide most amenities with 2 grocery stores, local sporting goods store and a small discount store. There are numerous restaurants, hotels and churches in town. The housing market in Buffalo is a little tight, but apartment rentals are available. There is no government housing available.

The Buffalo Field Office is responsible for management of about 800,000 acres of public land in Sheridan, Johnson and Campbell Counties. We manage a diversity of rangelands from the southern Big Horns through the Powder River Basin to the fringes of the Black Hills. The office also manages a large mineral estate, including much of the coalbed methane industry in the Powder River Basin.
