The Society for Range Management Student Conclave (SC) announces the launch of their fundraiser for those impacted by the recent wildfires in Colorado, Kansas, Oklahoma, and Texas.

The SC has been working diligently to design t-shirts that are currently for sale, the proceeds of which will be donated to support this cause. The t-shirt features the image of the four states that were impacted by the wildfires, along with the messages, “Pay Up for the Panhandle”, and “Whatever the flames claim, livelihoods still remain”.

The t-shirts are available through a Spirit Store offered by No Dinx, Inc., <https://range-management.gear4acause.com/>. Spirit Stores are designed specifically for fundraisers and have products available for a three-week window. You can purchase the “Pay Up for the Panhandle” t-shirts for \$15 from April 12th, 2017 to April 26th, 2017 with an approximate ship date of May 3rd, 2017.

Four organizations have been identified which have already established systems for distributing relief funds to local farmers and ranchers: Colorado Farm Bureau, Kansas Livestock Association, Oklahoma Cattlemen’s Association, and Texas Farm Bureau. Each organization has implemented similar processes for allocating funds in which those affected can apply for specific needs such as livestock reimbursement, fencing supplies, etc. A committee from these respective organizations then determines what funds are appropriate to disperse. Funds raised by the Conclave’s efforts will be distributed to these four organizations to be dispersed where they are needed most.

The agriculture community is known for its resilience and support for one another.
